They achieved their first ISO certification in 2017 as the only bulk food transporter in the world. These two initial certifications earned, were not only an industry first, but a global first in governance of food safety.

Continually focused on improvement through weekly audits and aligning practices, Oakley was able to re-certify ISO 9001:2015 and earn ISO 22000:2018, adding their dry van and reefer divisions and upgrading to the newest food safety protocols with the certification of ISO 22000:2018, once again being the only bulk food transporter in the world to hold these two specific industry certifications.

All employees are trained to follow certain procedures according to the quality management system and the effectiveness of those procedures are continuously improved through ongoing internal audits. Oakley partnered with Lloyd's Register, a

management system compliance company. LR's assessment methods look at overall management systems from compliance to performance, to reduce business risk, and enhance the effectiveness, efficiency, and continuous improvement of a company's internal systems. Certification audits were performed and determined that all of Oakley's processes, procedures, equipment, and service not only were reliable, accurate, and effective but also meet international standards of ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 22000:2018

As a food transporter, it is critical that Oakley Transport establishes uniform procedures and processes to ensure all their clients' products are delivered in the same condition in which they were loaded. ISO certification establishes a detailed road map for Oakley to help maintain meticulous and robust control over all transportation operations, catching issues before goods are moved.
